The Burpee Company was founded in Philadelphia in 1876 by an 18-year old with a passion for plants &amp; a mother willing to lend him \$1000 of "seed money" to get started in the business!</p>
<p><b>21st</b>—In 1959, Alf Dean landed a 16-foot 10" great white shark with his rod and reel in Australia. It weighed in at 2,664 pounds. That's the largest fish hooked by rod and reel on record! <b>27th</b>—In 1947, Babe Ruth Day was held at Yankee Stadium. 58,339 people attended the ceremony at "The house that Ruth built."</p>	<p><b>27th</b>—In 2011, the United States experienced a record number of tornadoes.
